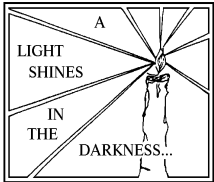

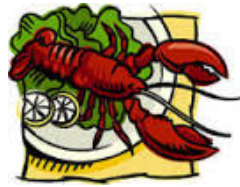
WYD2016 & Jubilee of Mercy Life-Changing Pilgrimage for Young Adults
